TENNIS SUMMER CAMP MISSION

FOR THE LOVE OF TENNIS summer camp emphasizes developing the love of the sport, and the essential tennis and athletic fundamentals of all players to provide them the opportunity to pursue tennis recreationally or competitively. It is a fun camp for beginner and intermediate level children. Our staff teaches campers the fundamentals of tennis in a fun atmosphere. Campers will learn a variety of strokes, rallying, serving, playing points, and learn the rules and etiquette of the game. Through the combination of a variety of fun tennis / fitness drills and games, children will further develop their overall athleticism, build lasting friendships and will have days full of dynamic activities.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up

- We kindly ask that your child is dropped off at 9:00 a.m. and picked up promptly at 12:00 p.m.
- If an alternate parent / guardian that is unfamiliar to our staff will be picking up your camper, please advise them that they will need to show proof of ID before the camper is released to them

RAIN POLICY

- FOR THE LOVE OF TENNIS camps will run outdoors at the Paris tennis courts
- In the event of inclement weather during the camp, your child's primary contact will be notified by phone/email and your child **must** be picked up within 20 minutes for their safety
- Primary contact will be notified 30 minutes prior to the summer camp start time if the entire lesson day needs to be rescheduled due to inclement weather
 - Parents / guardians will be notified by email if rain is almost certain
- As a make-up, your child will receive a rain check that can be used to attend any remaining day of camp during the rest of the summer
- If inclement weather occurs after 10:00 a.m. (over an hour into the camp), a rain date will not be reschedule

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

- A first aid/CPR-C certified staff member will always be present in the event of an emergency
- A first aid emergency kit will be carried by a staff member at all times
- Medications (e.g., Tylenol, allergy, inhaler, insulin, etc.) of any form **will not** be administered by our staff, except in the event of a medical emergency (e.g., Epi-pen)

OUR STAFF

Our certified, experienced, and passionate coaches will provide a fun, healthy, and educational environment for kids to learn tennis and build friendships. Our staff consists of individuals with university degrees, Tennis Canada coaching certifications, sport / coaching background and childcare experience. Our certified coaches are enthusiastic and professional individuals who are members of Tennis Canada's Tennis Professionals Association.

PAYMENT

- The cost for the summer camp week is \$235.00
- E-transfer payment must be received at least 30 days prior to the start of the summer camp
 - Your child is not fully registered or guaranteed a spot in the summer camp until payment is received

 - Email confirmation will be issued to e-transfer payments
- Payment may be made in the form of cash

 - Campers will **not be signed-in or allowed to stay** if the cash payment is not received at the start of the first camp day

REFUNDS & ABSENTEEISM

- If the cancellation request is received more than 14 days prior to the first day of camp, the camper will receive a credit transferable towards another week of tennis camp
- No refunds will be granted if notice is given less than 14 days prior to the start of the program, except for extenuating circumstances
- Missed days of camp will not be reimbursed

PLEASE NOTE: The camp staff will monitor but **cannot** administer medication. Staff are not responsible for storing medication or “missed doses”.

Anaphylaxis Management

Anaphylaxis Management and the use of epinephrine auto-injectors (e.g., Epi-pen) is a shared responsibility. Practicing emergency drills with your child results in effective emergency response in the case of a reaction.

Campers must be mindful of their allergies. Campers should:

- Carry at least one epinephrine auto-injector (e.g., Epi-pen) as age appropriate
- Wear medical identification (Medical Alert Bracelet) or inform staff members
- Inform staff if he/she suspects a reaction is occurring
- Ensure that asthma is well controlled and managed in the appropriate environment (all camp activities will be outdoor)

In the case of a camper experiencing a severe, potentially life threatening allergic reaction, staff will administer the epinephrine auto-injector and call 911. The child’s emergency contact will then be notified of the situation.

Behaviour Contract

FOR THE LOVE OF TENNIS reserves the right to ask parents to withdraw their child from the tennis camp without refund, if basic behaviour expectations are not met.

Examples:

- Verbal or physical abuse against campers or staff
- Stealing or any other illegal actions
- Behaviour that causes constant distraction for other campers or staff
- Constant disregard towards staff direction or guidance

It is understood that participants will be properly supervised and that reasonable safety precautions will be taken. Upon signing this form, permission is given to FOR THE LOVE OF TENNIS and its staff to seek medical care in the case of an emergency for the above registrant. Any cost incurred for medical care will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian.
